

PROGRAM AND ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Our graduate programs provide a rigorous learning environment for students who are serious about furthering their business education and careers.

Note: If you are applying for the 11-Month MBA, Executive MBA, the Executive MBA in Health Administration, or the Global Energy Management (GEM) Program, please refer to the website for specific application requirements.

PREVIOUS EDUCATION

We review your complete academic record, including GPA and previous coursework. We accept a variety of undergraduate degrees, but they must be from an accredited institution.

TESTING

The Graduate Management Admissions Test (GMAT) is required for admission. The Business School uses the test as one predictor of academic performance. The average GMAT score of admitted students is 580.

If you wish to waive the GMAT based on a previous graduate degree, the admissions committee will examine your graduate transcripts to determine if you have the necessary verbal and quantitative baseline for admission. Students completing the General Business Certificate at CU South Denver with a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher and earning a B+ or better in BUSN 6550, are elegible to request a waiver of the GMAT when applying to the professional MBA.

Some graduate programs also consider the GRE test. If you wish to be considered with your previous GRE score, indicate that when you submit your application. Most programs require a 20 percentile or better for the verbal and quantitative secions. The admissions team will let you know if your GRE scores have been accepted. Evidence of English language proficiency may be required: ITELTS: 6.5, TOEFL: 75, PTE: 51 (see full policy for details).

WORK EXPERIENCE

A relevant background and a history of increasing responsibility are viewed positively, but not required for admission.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Submit complete application materials with a non-refundable application fee. Applications are available on our website at business.ucdenver.edu/admissions.

GENERAL BUSINESS SCHOOL REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for graduation, students should have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher and complete all degree requirements within the times allocated: five years for MBA and MS degrees and seven years for dual degrees.
